**Report on Tuberculosis Active Case Finding (ACF) Campaign Monitoring at
Yelahanka TU in Bangalore Urban District – July 2018**

Acute Case Finding (ACF) is a strategy under RNTCP, where in the systematic identification of people with suspected active TB, in a predetermined target group, using tests, examinations or other procedures, by means of doing house to house survey by the health workers.

For this activity our institution was allotted Yelahanka TU for External Monitoring for Active case finding of Tuberculosis in Bangalore Urban District from July 2nd to July 13th, 2018. Faculty from Community Medicine department undertook the monitoring on 5 days, viz., 4th, 6th, 9th, 12th and 13th July 2018.
